## Varsity Quiz Highlights

LPBC You Will Be Silent-140, LPBC The Greeks-10, • Shadows of Death-90
Second-year quizzer Raine O'Ryan got Heart off to a fast start, grabbing the first two questions. Heart teammate Jessica Matthews was next to score, followed by rookie Jeremy Kline putting Lake Pointe You Will Be Silent on the board. Raine then did something she had never done before-she froze her chair, and that without error. Going into question 8 , the score was $20-0-90$. But the next four scores all came from the Silencers, as Julia Mayer scored once and Gloria Mayer scored three times for a team bonus and a frozen chair. After question 12, the score was 110-0-90. Grant Mayer got Lake Pointe The Greeks on the board, before the Silencers went back to work, Gloria adding a freebie and Jeremy closing out the quiz with another 20 for the biggest win of the day.

This quiz saw another fast start from Heart, this time with Jessica Matthews taking the first two
 questions. Lake Pointe's Sophia Fike was next to score, followed by Marimont's John Hassenzahl. Jessica then got her third answer to freeze her chair, and the score was 20-60-20 after question 12. But the Heart lead evaporated in just two questions as Arianna Hassenzahl and Lydia Hatfield combined to give Marimont a team bonus and a 10 -point lead going into question 15. Though mired in third place, Lake Pointe did not sit back. A Lake Pointe error on question 15 set up a tossup for the win between Heart and Marimont, but both teams passed on the question. On question 16, Sophia added to her personal total and ended the quiz.
Marimont Overcome by Sleep-30, Marimont Something to Eat-10, LPBC The Greeks-120 The Sleepers were presumably optimistic for another win here considering Lake Pointe's The Greeks had scored all of 40 points in their first two quizzes. And things started off looking like a close quiz was in store. Noah Trevino began the scoring for Marimont Something to Eat. The next score was a freebie by Lake Pointe's Caleb Yonker, followed by a freebie by the Sleepers' Arianna Hassenzahl. Then Lake Pointe's Sophia Fike scored and the Sleeper's John Hassenzahl scored, so after question 10 the score was 30-20-30. ## Marimont Fill in the _-70, OCS Good 4 Us 2 Be Here-0, LPBC In (the) Time-90

In his first quiz ever, OCS rookie Matthew Magro fearlessly got the jump on question one against two teams composed of almost all veterans. As it turned out, Matthew went three-and-out in this quiz but came back strong in the next two to lead all JV rookies on the day. Lake Pointe was first on the board as Carmen Yonker scored on the question-two toss-up. But the next three scores all went to Owen Parker, to freeze his chair without error and take a 50-point Marimont lead. Carmen scored again and Cordelia Fike scored twice to retake the lead by 10 for Lake Pointe. Going into question 15, the score was 70-0-80. A Lake Pointe error meant a 10 -point deduction but the other teams passed on the toss-up question, so the quiz proceeded to a tie-breaker. Cordelia got the jump and answer to freeze

## - Baptized with Fire-70, Marimont Fill in the __50, OCS Good 4 Us 2 Be Here- 40

 The OCS rookie duo scored first with Matthew Magro getting his first 20 points ever on question 2. Heart scored next, tying for the early lead with 20 from Micah Gendich. OCS went back in front as Matthew scored again. Owen Parker put Marimont on the board, tied with Heart and just one score back from OCS. It was, however, Heart rookie Kaleb Caran-Martin who got his first score ever to tie it up again for the lead. Marimont's fourth team error saw it lose 10 points, putting it 30 behind the other two teams. But Sam Hatfield scored two in a row to vault Marimont from third place to its first lead, sending the quiz into question 15 with the score $40-50-40$. Whichever of the three teams got question 15 would win. Heart's other rookie, Noel Alvarez, got the jump and answer for his first score ever, winning the quiz with a team bonus and getting the quizmaster's choice award to be in next month's raffle.
OCS Good 4 Us 2 Be Here-50, LPBC In (the) Time-40, OCS You Will Laugh-60
This was the surprise upset of the day, and it kept the high-scoring Lake Pointe duo from starting the season in first place. OCS You Will Laugh was scoreless in their first two quizzes, but Ethan Townsend got the jump and the answer on question 1 in this quiz. Luke Umphrey tried to extend Laugh's lead on question 2 but came up short on the answer and passed the baton to rookie schoolmate Trenten Algate of 2 Be Here, whose first jump ever on question 3 also resulted in an error. Cordelia Fike picked up the free question to put Lake Pointe on the board. Luke then scored his 40 points on the day to extend Laugh's lead, but Cordelia and Carmen Yonker matched his effort to pull within 10 again. The score starting question 13 was $0-50-60$. Both Lake Pointe and Laugh erred, and Trenten took the freebie for his 10 points on the day. Rookie Matthew Magro grabbed question 14, and now the score was $30-50-60$ with one question to go. In a bid to win, Lake Pointe got the jump but not the answer for a 10 -point deduction. On the toss-up, Matthew got the jump and the answer to pull 2 Be Here into second place, and Laugh hung on for the win. 2

## TIPS AND TRICKS:

Contests (R 3.6) and Reviews (R 3.9)
When the quizmaster's decision is questionable, what can be done and by whom?

possible action<br>contest/rebut request review<br>keep quiet<br>\section*{appropriate person(s)<br><br>answering quizzer or acting captain<br><br>coach<br><br>other teammates and audience}

1. A contest is a request to the quizmaster (1) to change a ruling that a quizzer's answer is either correct or incorrect, (2) to throw out the question, or (3) to correct a rule violation.

- Example. On a regular question, the quizzer's answer is not completely accurate. The contest and rebuttal should indicate what the quizzer said, what the scripture says, and why the difference between the two either does or does not matter.
- Example. On a regular question, the quizzer pauses and is called incorrect. The quizzer or the quizzer's captain may contest that the quizzer was quoting material just before the answer and would have continued to the answer if allowed the full 30 seconds. Therefore the question should be thrown out.
- Example. On a memory question, the quizzer quotes accurately but goes beyond the requested verse and is counted incorrect. The contest would be that the local rule (R5.2) permits quoting past the verse (though the rule is different at WBQA sponsored tournaments like Great Lakes and Chicago).

2. A review is a request by a coach to the quizmaster to correct a rule violation either before or after a quizzer/captain contests.

- Example. A quizzer's light was not on and the quizmaster states that he will throw out the question. The coach may ask the quizmaster to review his ruling on the basis that all questions asked while the quizzer's light was off must be thrown out (R 6.2.5).
- Example. After listening to her recording, the quizmaster rules that she could not hear the quizzer state a necessary word. No rule violation has occurred so a coach cannot request a review to try and convince the quizmaster that the quizzer did say the needed word. [In practice, on rare occasions, coaches have succeeded with a review in this kind of case because even quizmasters can have a bad day.]
- Example. Following a contest, the quizmaster throws out a question and announces the replacement question. The coach may request review of the replacement question type ( $R$ 3.7.3): a regular question should be replaced with a regular question, a memory question with a memory, and a reference question with the specific CV or CO subtype (see R5.1.8 - there is exactly one CV and one CO in a packet).

Check your map or use your GPS for this one unless you are familiar with the local roads. If you are near to or south of M-59, that provides an easy route: exit at N .
