on your own. Plan on whatever meals you will have while traveling and then add Friday dinner, Saturday lunch and dinner, and Sunday lunch going home. You should have somewhere between 4-7 total meals depending on when you travel. If you eat downtown, figure \$12-20 dollars a meal plus parking unless you go strictly fast food, and who wants to do that when you're in Chicago, right?

When Are Things Happening?

The first meeting will be on Friday night March 25 at 9:00pm (Chicago time) at the hotel in the conference room we have reserved. This is a mandatory meeting for all Detroit Bible Quizzing participants. Quizzing starts at 8:00am at the church on March 26 but plan on being there a little earlier than that. On Sunday morning, March 27, there will be a short World quizzing informational meeting at 8:30am. We will then have a joint worship service/sharing time starting at 9:00am back in the conference room. Afterwards, we head for home.

How Much Will This Cost?

The cost for coaches and room sponsors staying in DBQ rooms is \$65.00 which includes your 2 nights at the hotel, Saturday and Sunday breakfast and a T-shirt. Quizzers staying in a DBQ sponsored room cost \$75.00. Cost of family rooms will be \$210 for 2 nights, maximum 4 person occupancy. Quizzers staying in a family room cost an additional \$25 per quizzing to cover the tournament team fee and DBQ T-shirt. T-shirts for spectators can be purchased separately (\$10) but must be ordered in advance. All money is due to Cindy Hatfield no later than March 12, 2011 at 8pm. No exceptions will be made. No money, no going to the tournament. Checks should be made out to Detroit Bible Quizzing. You may only pay by credit card for all of the above charges at our website, www.detroitbiblequizzing.org. If you have any questions or concerns about paper registrations, Cindy Hatfield (586-918-7506) can help you. If it's about online registrations, Mike Miller (586-264-4692) can walk you through what you need to do or answer any concerns that you may have.

How Are Teams Made Up?

Every quizzing who qualifies for the tournament gets placed in a pool. A team of quizzing leaders made up of DBQ Steering Committee members, parents, and coaches get together and put the teams together like an intricate puzzle. This team makeup committee considers a quizzers local performance all year long (especially in the March tournament), their home location and how close they are to other quizzers in their area, their specialization (if they have one) and overall team chemistry. Each team is then assigned a coach that best fits that team's makeup.

When Is The All Team Practice?

Sunday March 20, from 2-4pm, snow or not, we will be having an all team practice. It is required for all quizzers & coaches attending. It will be at Fellowship Chapel in Sterling Heights, MI.

What About Transportation To Chicago?

Each church or quizzing group is responsible for its own transportation. There may be room in another church's van for you if you need a ride, but you must make your need known. Call Mike Miller at (586) 264-4692 and see if he knows anyone with space.

What About Food?

Both Saturday's and Sunday's breakfasts are included in the cost of the trip. It is a full breakfast buffet. On Saturday, plan on eating sometime between 6am-7:00am. Sunday can be a bit later from 7:30am to 9:00am. All of your remaining meals for the weekend will be

What About The Hotel?

We will be headed back to the Springhill Suites in Warrenville, IL. Their address is 4305 Weaver Parkway, Warrenville, IL 60555. Their phone number is 630-393-0400. It is about 18 miles southeast of the church. If you arrive earlier than your adult room sponsor, you will not be allowed in your room. Put your luggage in someone else's room temporarily until your adult room sponsor shows up. Look inside this info pack for a map on how to get around. Plan on it taking approximately 5-6 hours to get there from the Detroit area.

Where Is The Quiz Being Held?

We will be back at First Baptist Church of Geneva, IL. The address is 2300 South Street, Geneva, IL 60134. There is a map from the hotel to the church inside this info pack. Plan on a 30 minute drive from the hotel. It is about 18 miles northwest of the hotel.

How Does Someone Get A DBQ T-Shirt?

Each quizzing and coach from DBQ going to Chicago this year will be given a team shirt with a similar design but with different colors. Non quizzers, fans, and parents have the option of ordering a shirt in advance. This shirt will be a different color than any of the teams. The cost for each shirt is \$10.00.

What Stuff Should Be Brought?

A notarized medical release form must be filled out by parents for every child 17 & under. It should then be given to the adult who is sponsoring the student for the weekend or the driver of the vehicle they are riding in. (NOTE: if a parent is riding with their child they do not need to bring this), bathing suit (if you are planning on swimming), quiz portion and study materials (for last minute review!), rain coat and/or umbrella (in case of wet weather) and clothing appropriate for the season (stay warm!).

Guidelines For Your Behavior

- 1) Absolutely positively no guys in girl's rooms and no girls in guy's rooms at any time for any reason EXCEPT for a team practice with your coach(es) present OR when everybody wants to hang out together AND there are at least 2 ADULT sponsors overseeing it at all times in the room.
- 2) Believe it or not, there are other people other than ourselves staying at this hotel :-). Please keep this in mind as you walk the hallways. Remember to talk with one another at REGULAR or lower than usual volume levels in the hallways. Bottom line: be considerate of others.
- 3) Observe all meeting times and curfew times which will be announced at Friday night's meeting at the hotel.
- 4) No alcohol, drugs, tobacco products, lighters, fireworks, squirt guns, or knives allowed at any time or for any reason.

The Map Page


How To Get To Where We're All Going



To The Hotel From Detroit

Take I-94 heading west to Chicago. When you enter Indiana, start paying attention to road signs. You want to stay on I-94 but it combines with I-80 in Indiana. Once you cross into Illinois, begin looking for I-294, otherwise known as the Tri-State Tollway. Yes you will have to pay a few tolls along the way. Take I-294 west (or it could be north) about 25 miles until you come to I-88. Take I-88 west for about 15 miles until you come to the exit for Winfield Road (exit 125). You

will turn left off of the highway on to Winfield Rd. Take that for .4 miles and you'll turn left on Diehl Rd. You'll drive .17 miles and turn left onto Weaver Parkway which is the road that the hotel is on. You should have seen the hotel signs well before these last few turns. In fact, you should be able to see the hotel from the highway.



From The Hotel To Quizzing Location

Get back to I-88 from the hotel by turning right out of the hotel parking lot, then turning right on to Diehl Rd. Then right again on to Winfield Rd, which crosses over I-88. You're going to get on I-88 heading west and take it for approx. 10 miles. You will be getting off the highway at Orchard Rd. (exit 115). At the end of the ramp you will turn right (north). Take Orchard for almost 2.5 miles and bear left onto Randall Rd. Stay on Randall for about 4 miles. You will be passing many restaurants on

your way. You will come to South St. where you will bear to the right. The church should be just up the road after you turn.

How to Get Downtown From The Hotel

Leave the hotel and get back out to I-88 and take it east for about 15 miles. It will then blend into I-290 east which will take you all the way downtown. You can decide where to go from there.
