DBQ 1-2 Finish in Great Lakes Regional Varsity Finals



DBQ Berry-N-Creams

DBQ Berry-N-Creams and DBQ About 100 Years Old ended the preliminaries in first and second respectively. Berrien Speak and Prevail moved up from the fourth spot to join them in the Finals.

All three teams demonstrated that they were well prepared and had put in some serious concordance study. The Finals started with fast jumps on partial questions that would have meant little to the average quizzzer and nothing to spectators. exit at VanDyke Avenue, proceed north to 18 Mile Road where VanDyke splits; stay to the right to get on the M-53 freeway; exit at 23 Mile Road East. The church will be on the right.

from the M-59 corridor:

- from the east, turn right (north) on Schoenherr Road, proceed north three miles to 23 Mile Road, turn left (west) and the church will be a little more than 1/2 a mile on the left.

- from the west, about a mile after the freeway ends and becomes Hall Road, turn left onto M-53 north, go three miles, exit at 23 Mile Road East and the church will be on the right.

alternate route from the west:
transfer from I-696 to M-59 by taking Telegraph Road north to Square Lake Road east to I-75 north, and then follow the directions for M-59 from the west.
