Quizzing Tips for November 8

Exclusion of the Genealogy. Questions this year will *not* cover verse 24 to the end of chapter 3. This excludes the genealogy, except that you may get questions about the son of Joseph, the son of Heli from verse 23.

Situation Questions. In the Rulebook and in the question book, there is a list of the interrogatives that can be asked for the Situation specialty. Examples are "Who", "To Whom" and so on. "Situation" does not appear in that list, but you will find in the question book that there are several questions that do call for a "Situation." Those should not be there and will not be asked in the quiz. You may (and should) safely ignore them.

Rookie Watch. A great part of quizzing it to see which rookies start off strong and which are able to catch on later and make a run for the top spot. October saw one Varsity rookie, **Joshua Howell**, get the first points of his career. In JV, three had 100 points or more: **Elizabeth Jordan**, **Andrew Bellanti** and **Anna Curley**. In Little League, **Summer Baut** was the October standout with 120 points.

Tournament Watch. While the upcoming Great Lakes Regional Tournament is open to all, remember that the Chicago Tournament next spring has two threshold requirements for DBQ participation. One is attendance: you can't miss more than one day of quizzing throughout the season and you must be at the March Tournament. Two is a minimum scoring average: rookies need a 10-point average and veterans a 20-point average. Assuming a full season of 21 quizzes, that amounts to 210 points for rookies and 420 points for veterans.

The first half of this quiz belonged to **Kristina Cherniausky** who froze without error on question 6 and added 20 more on question 8. Teammate **Rachel Dober** added 20 on question 9 to give Living Word a total of 110. Fellowship gradually worked itself into the quiz: **Michele Weidner** and **Mike Dettloff** laid the groundwork on questions 4 and 5; when **Nina Darcie** jumped on question 10 that resulted in a third-person team bonus, and when Nina got 12 and 13A as well she froze her chair without error for a bonus. In fact, Fellowship now had the lead with 120 points. Not to be outdone on the team front, **Emily Wheatley** took question 14 to give LW a team bonus and a 20-point lead. Fellowship's effort to tie on question 15 came up short, and Kristina got the toss-up to seal the LW win. **Yewon Youm** accounted for Cornerstone's points.

With a frozen chair bonus available, Ade went for the win on question 15 but came up short. **Brittany Matthews** won the toss-up for a Heart team bonus and the victory.

Each team in this quiz got a one-point high score bonus added to their team points. There was only one error, and four quizzers froze (three without error). **Jordan Hatfield** spotted Fellowship to an early lead that **Rachel Weidner** extended on question 3. Showing her Quizzer of the Month form, **Kayla Kauzlarich** froze her chair on question 6 and put Heart in the lead. Cornerstone Quote This was not to be counted out—they got on the board on question 5 with a jump from **Sarah Hoffman**, then picked up 20 more on question 9 with a jump from rookie **Anna Curley**, and Sarah added 60 more with a freebie and two more jumps to freeze her chair without error on question 14A. Going into question 15, the score was now 100-110-0. For the second quiz of the day, Quote This had come from quite a bit down to put itself in a position to win. At this point, don't think that Heart was a non-factor in this quiz—the all-rookie team had been striving mightily, and every member had at least one error (in fact, the team had a total of six errors).
