Varsity Quiz Highlights

Berrien Futile – 40, Berrien One Body – 110, Northridge On The Move – 100



Berrien Futile

Northridge's **Nailah Davis** almost pulled off a victory singlehandedly in this quiz. She froze without error on question 8, and with a freebie along the way, that gave Northridge a 20-20-80 lead. **Stephen Cabe** and **Stephen Dubs** put Futile and One Body respectively on the board. By question 12, each of those three quizzers had scored again so the score was 40-40-100. With just three questions left, could either of the Berrien teams score 60 points or more? Yes. One Body's **Noah Prahlow** scored on 13, Stephen froze with error on 14, and **Samuel Prahlow** scored 20 points on 16 (after 15 was passed) for a team bonus that gave One Body the come-from-behind victory.

OCC The Pink Bible Quizzers – 60, HH Weak and Sick – 110, Berrien The Secret Things of God – 80

The Pink's **Kristina Cherniausky** scored 40 points and **Rachel Dober** ended regulation with 20. 
