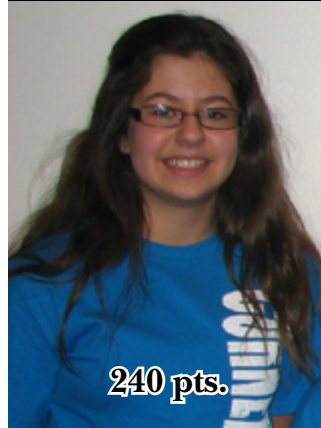

The Good Shepherd.

In his extended metaphor in John 10 about shepherding sheep, Jesus said that *“All who ever came before me were thieves and robbers.”* This statement has given scholars fits in deciding just who Jesus was talking about. However, everyone is agreed that he was not referring to the Old Testament patriarchs, judges, prophets and kings who believed in and followed God. So what Jesus said about shepherding builds on what we find in the Old Testament.

David is a great example to look at because he was not only a shepherd of sheep in his youth, but he then became a leader of people as king of Israel. David was not at all like the hired hand that runs from a wolf; in 1 Samuel 17, he describes defending the sheep: *“34 Your servant has been keeping his father’s sheep. When a lion or a bear came and carried off a sheep from the flock, 35 I went after it, struck it and rescued the sheep from its mouth. When it turned on me, I seized it by its hair, struck it and killed it. 36 Your servant has killed both the lion and the bear.”*

In light of his experiences taking care of his family’s sheep, David had the following insight into God taking care of us:

1 The LORD is my shepherd, I shall not be in want. 2 He makes me lie down in green pastures, he leads me beside quiet waters, 3 he restores my soul. He guides me in paths of righteousness for his name’s sake. 4 Even though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death, I will fear no evil, for you are with me; your rod and your staff, they comfort me. 5 You prepare a table before me in the presence of my enemies. You anoint my head with oil; my cup overflows. 6 Surely goodness and love will follow me all the days of my life, and I will dwell in the house of the LORD forever.”

That of course is Psalm 23. ☘
