Little League Quiz Highlights

Faithful Brothers' **Jared Elmers** scored the first 60 points of this quiz. Heritage tied it up on the combined efforts of rookie **Haley Sargent** (20 points) and **Owen Parker** (40 points). Question 15 arrived with the score 60-60-0. Cornerstone made good use of its last chance to get on the board with a score from **Ian Bacheldor**. That sent the quiz into overtime to break the tie for first place. A Heritage error led to a free question taken by Jared to win the quiz.

This quiz featured three frozen chairs and no errors. With no errors, the frozen quizzers had no toss-ups to get extra points. **Jared Elmers** started out fast for Faithful Brothers, freezing without error with jumps on questions 1, 2 and 4. **Micah Farrand** got question 3 and teammate **Blake Matthews** got question 6 for Fearless Brothers. **Paul Johnecheck** got question 5 and rookie teammate **Tim Patawarn** got question 8 for Cornerstone. At that point the score was 40-40-70 and was looking like it could be a close quiz. But the next four correct answers were shared between Micah and Blake to both freeze without error and give Fearless Brothers its big lead. Tim got his second jump on question 15 to end the quiz.

Quizateer rookie **Grace Adair** was up to the task and ended the quiz on a positive note of two correct answers in a row.
