Need-to-know for March 10 "Day of Champions" Tournament

The address and map for Fellowship Chapel in Sterling Heights are on the back of the newsletter. Quizmasters and quiz boxes are requested to be there by 7:45 a.m.

Please bring your quiz boxes. There will be more rooms in use than normal, so having some extra boxes available is important.

The opening meeting will start at 8:00 a.m. and the first quiz at 8:20 a.m. There will be six quizzes in the morning. After a lunch break, the playoff brackets will be announced. The playoffs, culminating in the Finals for each division, should conclude by 5:30 p.m. The day will be capped off with an awards ceremony, which will include the Champions and finalists, individual All Stars, Dream Team, Rookie of the Year and Most Improved Quizzer.

Finally, everyone going to the Chicago 2012 Tournament with DBQ needs to confirm that and make payment (either on-line or preferably in person to Cindy Hatfield) before heading home.

Remember, to go to Chicago as a quizzer on a DBQ team, you need a 20-point average if you're a veteran quizzer and a 10-point average if you are a rookie. You also cannot have missed more than one day of quizzing throughout the season and must be present for the March quizzes. Your final average is determined after the six preliminary quizzes in the March Day of Champions Tournament. So there are 6 more quizzes to get your average where you want or need it to be.

See what you can do to get family, friends, acquaintances involved now. Get them to one of your practices or to the March tournament. Varsity Quiz Highlights

LP The Old-70, Heart Radiance-20, HH All In-120 Lake Pointe got the early lead with two correct from

Rachel Weidner. Huron Hills answered back with one from Gabbie Perry and two from Genna Galura to move into the lead. LP got the lead back as Rachel froze without error for a bonus. Genna froze her chair to take the lead back for HH and Gabbie added to it with 20 points on question 12A. Question 13 was passed, and Michael Pappas got Heart on the board with 20 points on question 14, so Huron Hills went into question 15 with the lead secured as long as they did not jump and err. All they had to do was sit back and wait out whatever the other teams tried to do. But in fact on question 15 it was Gabbie jumping and getting it right for her first frozen chair since seventh grade!



Lake Pointe rookie Mike Dempster scored three in a row to freeze without error. Michael Pappas then got Heart on the board. Back in on a toss-up, Mike extended Lake Pointe's lead. Gabrielle Baut finally got Cornerstone on the board on question 9. Michael immediately grabbed second place back for Heart, only to see Gabrielle score two in a row to freeze her chair and reclaim second for CEPC. Going into question 13, the score was 60-90-40. LP rookie Gloria Mayer scored, which all but locked up the win. Back in on toss-ups after Heart bravely tried to catch second place, Gabrielle scored on question 14A and then again on 15A as LP obediently sat back on coach's instructions to preserve their win.

Nearsighted & Blind-110, The Superiors-130, CEPC Perfection-0

This was perhaps the Superiors' most satisfying win of the season. Down two errors and 90 points, they nevertheless fought back with a complete team effort to win at the last moment. Julia Elmers scored the first 70 points of the quiz to freeze without error; her sister Rachel Elmers followed that up with 20 more points and the Blind had its 90-point lead. Quizzer of the Month Allie Greff then scored two in a row to get The Superiors on the board. Rachel scored again, but Allie keep pace and froze her chair. Then Josh Farrand got the next question and The Superiors were only 30 points back going into question 13. That one was passed and Josh then got 14, so the deficit was now only 10 points going into the last question. Joe Greff got that one to vault The Superiors into the lead when it counted most-at the end, and it gaveThe Superiors a team bonus.

Little League Quiz Highlights

Heritage Exiles-70, CEPC By Faith-10, CEPC Punishers-50

By Faith rookie **Rachel Howe** scored first in this quiz with a freebie on question 3. The Exile's **Owen Parker** scored the next 60 points to freeze his chair and give his team a big lead by question 11. Then it was the turn of the Punishers' rookie **Tim Patawarn**, who scored 60 unanswered points to freeze his chair and end regulation with a tie. On the tie-breaker, the Punishers got the jump but not the answer. Rookie **Haley Sargent** made no mistake on the free question and gave the Exiles the overtime win.

CEPC Punishers-50, Faithful Brothers-80, The 3 Quizateers-60

Jared Elmers staked Faithful Brothers to a 40-point lead. The Quizateers answered back with two correct from Lydia Hatfield. Jared responded with one more to freeze his chair and take the lead back for the Brothers. The Punishers made their move as rookie Tim Patawarn scored 30 on a regular question and a freebie. A Quizateer error on 13 unfroze Jared who grabbed the toss-up and gave the Brothers a 40-point lead with two questions remaining. The Quizateers would need them both for a chance to win. But question 14 went to Tim, and the 20 points moved the Punishers into second place. The Brothers had their win secured. With the race on for second place, Lydia got question 15 to put the Quizateers back into second as the quiz ended.

CEPC Consuming Fire-110, CEPC Punishers-10, Fearless Brothers-150

The Fearless Brothers took the first four questions of this quiz for 90 points as **Micah Farrand** got question 1 and Quizzer of the Month **Blake Matthews** the next three to freeze without error. Question 5 went to Consuming Fire's **Hunter Ditchfield**, but an error on 6 let Blake back in to score on the toss-up. The score was 20-0-110. The two teams traded scores as **Ian Bacheldor** scored on question 9 and Micah matched that on 10 to maintain a 90-point lead. But then Fire scored two in a row by Ian and Hunter to make a comeback look doable. On question 13, rookie **Tim Patawarn** got the jump and the answer for the Punishers' lone score. This meant Fire would need both of the two remaining questions. Ian got the first one to freeze his chair without error and pull his team within just 20 points going into the last question. The Punishers got the jump on question 15 but not the answer, and that unfroze Ian and Blake for the deciding toss-up question. It was Blake that prevailed and sealed the victory for the Brothers.
