Please bring your quiz boxes. There will be more rooms in use than normal, so having some extra boxes available is important.

The opening meeting will start at 8:00 a.m. and the first quiz at 8:20 a.m. There will be six quizzes in the morning. After a lunch break, the playoff brackets will be announced. The playoffs, culminating in the Finals for each division, should conclude by 5:00 p.m. The day will be capped off with an awards ceremony, which will include the Champions and finalists, individual All Stars (top 25% for the season), Dream Team (top 4 quizzers on the day), Rookie of the Year and Most Improved Quizzer.

Finally, everyone going to the Chicago 2014 Tournament with DBQ needs to confirm that and make payment (in person to Cindy Hatfield) before heading home.

Rachel Elmers scored first for Justified. **Julia Elmers** scored next to put Eternal Power on the board. **Julia Mayer** scored two in a row to give Lake Pointe the lead. Rachel tied it up with her second, but Lake Pointe's Julia came right back with her third to freeze her chair and regain the lead. Eternal Power's Julia got the next one. **Jared Elmers** scored to pull Justified into a tie for the lead. EP's Julia then got her third to freeze and make it a three-way tie at 60 with three questions to go. On question 13, Jared got his second jump to give Justified sole possession of the lead for the second time in the quiz. Rookie **Cecil Coleman** got his first jump of the quiz and tied it up again for Lake Pointe. It was still anyone's quiz on question 15. Jared got the jump and the answer to freeze without error for the bonus and 30-point final differential.

Jessica scored her third on 14 to pull Heart within 20, but with her now frozen as well, Heart had no one to jump on question 15. Rookie **Hunter McGuire** got that last question to put Calvary Missionary on the board.

Lake Pointe was first on the board with a freebie by Grant Mayer. Lydia Hatfield grabbed the lead for Heart, but rookie Sophia Fike came right back with a 20-pointer to put Lake Pointe in the lead again. Danielle Leidy scored to put Calvary Missionary in the mix. Lydia got her second jump and Heart was in the lead again. But Grant got a 20-pointer to take the lead back. After a couple passed questions, Lydia froze without error to give Heart the lead for the third time in the quiz. Michael Pappas got 14 to seal the win for Heart. Danielle closed out the quiz.

A couple lessons come from this quiz: (1) read the rules, and (2) the rules don't account for every situation. Revelation's **Nicholas Skelton** took questions 1-3 for a frozen chair and got a toss-up on question 5 to seal Quizzer of the Month. Revelation rookie **Dale Martin** answered question 9. CMC's **Danielle Leidy** scored on question 11. The score stayed at 110-0-20 until question 15, when Revelation and CMC started coughing up points. Regulation finally ended on 19 when **Rachel Weidner** got the team bonus for Revelation. The tie-breaker continued to 25A when the quiz was called due to time. If anyone has an opinion about a reasonable question number at which any quiz should end, speak to a board member about it as a rule change ought to be considered.

Little League Quiz Highlights

NC Obtained Access-110, NC Under Grace-0, Taming the Tongue-140

Deven Dorie got a good start in this quiz toward his second consecutive Quizzer of the Month. Here, he got questions 1, 4 and 5 to quickly freeze without error. And with an answer by teammate **Sam Hatfield** on question 2, Taming the Tongue got off to a 90 point lead. Obtained Access got on the board on question 6 with a correct answer from **Ariel Elmers**. She got her second on question 11, sandwiched between two by top quizzer and rookie **Nathan Dempster**, and the lead was cut to just 10 points with three questions to go. On question 13, rookie **Philip Conner** got the jump and answer to give Taming the Tongue a team bonus and a 40-point lead. Obtained Access would now need to get both remaining questions to win. But on question 14, Philip got his second and secured the win for the Tongue. Ariel froze her chair without error on question 15 to close out the quiz.

CCC Obedient Slaves-0, CEPC h.o.g.G.-120, LP God's Children-30

After starting the season in fifth place, the Christ Community team came on strong with all three quizzers regularly contributing, and it seemed that on this day they were destined to take over first place. In fact, that did happen as they were able to put the results of this quiz behind them, win their next two and take over first by just a single Olympic point. Here, they got the quiz started with an error. **Ian Bacheldor** took the toss-up for a Cornerstone lead. Rookie **Micah Gendich** got question 3 to pull CCC into a tie. Again, CCC erred and rookie **Luke Conner** got the toss-up to put Cornerstone back in the lead. **Owen Parker** scored to tie it back up. On CCC's third error, rookie **Nathan Mayer** got the toss-up to put Lake Pointe on the board. After question 8, the score



Varsity team LP Hold Fast


was 40-40-20. The next two scores were negatives, as CCC errors led to deductions. Ian got his second correct to give Cornerstone a 40 point lead. Yet another CCC error saw it drop to third place, and Nathan picked up a freebie to help Lake Pointe's claim for second and maybe even to close the 30-point gap to first with two questions left. But Ian froze without error on question 14 to lock up Cornerstone's win. CCC's last error reduced its score to zero and the toss-up went to Cornerstone's **Rachel Howell** for a team bonus and a couple extra Olympic points.

How to get to Bethany Baptist:

from the west via I-696 corridor Take I-696 east to the M-97/Groesbeck exit (#26). Turn left onto Groesbeck heading north for four miles to 15 Mile Road. Turn right onto 15 Mile, going east for .2 mile. The church will be on your right (south side of 15 Mile).

from the northwest via M-59 corridor Take Van Dyke south to 15 Mile Road, turn left and head east just over five miles. Just past Groesbeck, the church will be on the right (south side).

Schedule

February 8: All quizzers, coaches, officials and parents are asked to complete the pre-registration form and turn it in by email, on the DBQ web site or at the February quiz. Even if you know that you will not be going to Chicago, it helps the Steering Committee to have that information.

March 8: Confirm you are going and make full payment to Cindy Hatfield by the end of the Day of Champions Tournament.

March 16: An All Teams Practice is tentatively scheduled for Lake Pointe Bible Church from 2–4:00pm Sunday afternoon. The address is 42150 Schoolcraft, Plymouth MI 48170.

March 28: 3:00pm hotel check-in. An orientation meeting will be held on Friday night at 9:00pm (Chicago time) at the hotel in the conference room we have reserved. This is a mandatory meeting for all Detroit Bible Quizzing participants.

March 29: On Saturday, breakfast at the hotel is between 6–7:15am. Quizzing starts at 8:00am at the church, but plan on being there a little earlier than that.

March 30: On Sunday morning, breakfast at the hotel is between 7:30–9:00am. We will have a joint worship service/sharing time starting at 9:00am back in the conference room. 12:00 noon check-out.

Fee Structure

The following costs are for 2 nights with breakfast both mornings.

DBQ rooms:

\$87: quizzers (includes team fee and T-shirt).

\$70: coaches, fans, officials, room sponsors (includes T-shirt).

Family rooms:

\$225: 4 person occupancy.

\$11: each additional person over 4 in a room.

\$27: <u>Quizzers staying in a family room</u> for team fee and DBQ T-shirt. \$10: T-shirts for non-quizzers (must be ordered in advance).

All money is due to Cindy Hatfield no later than March 8, 2014 at 8pm. Checks are preferred and should be made payable to Detroit Bible Quizzing.

How Are Teams Made Up?

Every quizzer who qualifies for the tournament gets placed in a pool. A team of quizzing leaders made up of DBQ Steering Committee members, parents and/or coaches get together and put the teams together like an intricate puzzle. This team makeup committee considers quizzers' local performance all year long (especially in the March tournament), their home location and how close they are to other quizzers in their area, their specialization (if they have one) and overall team chemistry. Each team is then assigned a coach that best fits that team's makeup.

Will There Be An All Teams Practice?

That is the plan; stay tuned for confirmation. Coaches are encouraged to get their teams together for an additional practice, and if you can do it with any other teams in your division that is even better.

What About Transportation To Chicago?

Each church or quizzing group is responsible for its own transportation. There may be room in another church's van for you if you need a ride, but you must make your need known.

What About Food?

Both Saturday's and Sunday's breakfasts are included in the cost of the trip. All of your remaining meals for the weekend will be on your own. Plan on whatever meals you will have while traveling and then add Friday dinner, Saturday lunch and dinner, and Sunday lunch going home. You should have somewhere between 4-7 total meals depending on when you travel.

How Does Someone Get A DBQ T-Shirt?

Each quizzer and coach will be issued a team shirt with the same design but a different color for each team. There will be a different color for parents and any other non-quizzer. For quizzers and for anyone staying in a DBQ room, the cost of the T-shirt is included in the individual room price or quizzer registration fee. For non-quizzers in family rooms, the cost for each shirt is \$10.00.

What Stuff Should Be Brought?

A notarized medical release form must be filled out by parents for every child 17 and under who will not be accompanied by a parent. What else: swimsuit for the pool, work-out gear for the health club, quiz portion and study materials (for last minute review!), clothing apropriate for the season (stay warm and dry!).

Make sure that you plan on getting to know others outside of your own church. Take a risk. Make a new friend.
