Curtis Parker started things off on question 1, and the other half of the 2 Disciples, Owen Parker, then scored three times to freeze without error for a 90 point lead. CrossPoint rookie Angelina Padilla, quizzing alone, scored twice in a row, and then picked up her third to freeze in between two more scores by Curtis that froze him without error.
