Bring snacks and there will be a lunch break when you can go out—or bring a lunch to eat at the church.

The address and map for Marimont Community Church in Pontiac are on page 3. Quizmasters and quiz boxes are requested to be there by 7:45 a.m.

Please bring your quiz boxes. There will be more rooms in use than normal, so having some extra boxes available is important.

The opening meeting will start at 8:00 a.m. and the first quiz at 8:30 a.m. There will be seven rounds of quizzing in the morning. After lunch, Varsity will finish out their regular season and the JV playoff brackets will be announced. Following the respective division Finals, the day will be capped off with an awards ceremony, which will include the Champions and finalists, individual All Stars (top 25% for the season), Dream Team (top 4 quizzers on the day), Rookie of the Year and Most Improved Quizzer.

Finally, everyone going to the Chicago 2017 Tournament with DBQ needs to confirm that and make payment (in person to Cindy Hatfield) before heading home.

Remember, to go to Chicago as a quizzer on a DBQ team, you should have a 20-point

Junior Varsity Quiz Highlights

OCS Good 4 Us 2 Be Here-110, CPC Don't Judge Us-40, LPBC In (the) Time-90

Top rookie **Matthew Magro** got question 1, but the next three scores were by Lake Pointe's Quizzer of the Month **Cordelia Fike** to freeze without error. She also was quizzing alone. Rookie **Angelina Padilla** then scored to put CrossPoint on the board. Matthew scored twice to freeze without error and regain a share of the lead, and rookie teammate **Jordan Johnson** scored to give OCS a 20 point lead. Angelina got her second score and immediately tried for her third in a bid to tie Cordelia, but she came up short and Cordelia got the toss-up to tie it up again with OCS. On question 15, Jordan got his second score to win the quiz for OCS.

♥ Baptized with Fire-30, OCS Good 4 Us 2 Be Here-200, OCS Joy and Delight-0

First place Heart's **Collin Gibson** started this quiz off on the right foot on question 1, but the rookie giant-killing duo of **Jordan Johnson** and **Matthew Magro** quickly grabbed the lead for OCS Good by taking the next three scores. Rookie **Noel Alvarez** scored to pull Heart within 20, but that was the last score by anyone but the dynamic duo. Matthew froze without error on question 10 and scored on two toss-ups for 110 points, while Jordan froze without error on question 11 and scored again on a toss-up for 90 points. All those errors led to a deduction for Heart, but it hung on for second.

OCS Rich Toward God-70, Marimont Fill in the ____40, OCS Good 4 Us 2 Be Here-130
The OCS Good rookie duo of Matthew Magro and Jordan Johnson had a stellar day, with the highest total team scores on the day—440 points, and rocketed their team from 6th place all the way up to 3rd. Still, in this quiz it was Marimont's Chloe Matthews who started the scoring, outjumping OCS Rich on a question-two toss-up. But then Jordan froze without error and Matthew froze, and they had 130 consecutive points that locked up the win. OCS Rich rookies Joshua Reyes and Ethan Degner then scored to move into second place. But Chloe got her second score to tie it up and send the quiz into overtime. Rookie Matt Collellti won the tie-breaker to give Rich second place with a third-person jumping bonus—10 extra points for the quiz score plus 2 extra Olympic points.

LPBC You Will Be Silent–110, ♥ Shadows of Death–90, Marimont Something to Eat–60
Varsity had its share of absentee quizzers as well. Here, Lake Pointe's Quizzer of the Month Gloria
Mayer was quizzing alone and took the first three questions to freeze without error. Heart's Jessica
Matthews scored, followed by Marimont's Jordan Hatfield, who was also quizzing alone. Jessica
scored again, followed by Jordan's error and Gloria won the toss-up. Jessica froze without error,
followed by Jordan freezing. This left the two Heart rookies eligible to jump with the score 90–70–
60; victory was theirs for the taking. But Cody Cundiff valiantly tried one he was unsure of and took
an error, and the toss-up went to Gloria for the win—a 40-point lead with one question left. Chey
Moeser got that one for her first jump ever.

LPBC The Greeks–160, Marimont Overcome by Sleep–20, LPBC You Will Be Silent–130 Silent's Gloria Mayer could not quite pull out another win in this quiz. She was first on the board and froze without error on question 4. The Greeks' Sophia Fike was close behind her, freezing without error on question 7. In that stretch, Ari Hassenzahl got Marimont on the board. Grant Mayer scored to give The Greeks the lead, but a Greek error let Gloria back in and she tied it up.

Grant scored again to take the lead back, but a Marimont error let Gloria back in and she tied it up again. Grant scored to freeze without error, so The Greeks took a 30 point lead into question 15. With three quizzers frozen, The Greeks' **Caleb Yonker** was jumping against Marimont. He got the jump but not the answer for -10, and Gloria got the toss-up to tie it up yet again and move into overtime. But on the tiebreaker, Caleb was the only one eligible to jump so he got the win with a third-person jumping bonus, and The Greeks moved into first place in Varsity.


March 11, 2017 Day of Champions

Marimont is on the north side of Walton Boulevard in Pontiac just west of Telegraph Road. The driveway into the parking lot is on the west side of the church.

via M-59 from the east:

Come west to Woodward, turn right and half-way around the loop turn right on Cesar Chavez Avenue. At Telegraph, turn right. At Walton, turn left and the church will be on your right.

from the I-696 corridor: From the east, take I-75 north to M-59 and follow the directions above. From the west, take Telegraph north all the way to Walton, turn left and the church will be on your right.
