**Plan now for Chicago.** In March, Detroit Bible Quizzing will put together teams of qualified quizzers to compete at the WBQA Chicago Tournament, now recognized as the World Championship. To qualify, a quizzer must meet two requirements. The first requirement is to have a 20-point average as a veteran or a 10-point average as a rookie. This season, one veteran, **Owen Parker**, and two

#### **November Quiz Highlights**

#### OCS You Must Decrease-110, LP Why does this concern us?-60, LP A Dispute-40

A shout-out goes to the Yonkers who, one-each on three different teams, quizzed without any of their Lake Pointe teammates. This quiz started slowly, with only one score in the first six questions: Megan Yonker of LP A Dispute scored on question 3. But, in a welcome turnaround, question 7 through the end of the quiz were all answered correctly. Question 7 was taken by Erin Yonker of LP Why does this concern us?. Question 8 went to Matthew Magro of Oakland Christian Schools. With the quiz half over, there was a three-way tie at 20 points each. Megan then got her second jump, Marlena Munch scored for OCS, and Erin got her second score. Going into question 12, there was again a three-way tie, now at 40 points each. OCS then got two in a row from Matthew and Annaliese Sanchez for a team bonus that made victory almost certain with two questions left. Erin scored and froze her chair, so she could only watch what would happen on question 15 as second place was still in jeopardy. But Marlena got her second jump to pad OCS's lead and end the quiz.

#### LP Why does this concern us?-10, ♥ About To Die-90, SPN Steal & Kill & Destroy-80,

Here is another quiz where, going into question 12, there was a three-way tie at 40 points. Heart's **Raine Lily O'Ryan** scored on questions 2 and 4, St Paul rookies **Rachel George** and **Jack Smith** on 3 and 7, and Lake Pointe's **Erin Yonker** on 10 and 11. It was all Heart and SPN down the stretch, each getting two scores, and the difference for the quiz was one bonus. Jack took 12 and 14 to freeze his chair with an error; Raine Lily on 13A froze her chair *without error*. With the score 40–70–80 as question 15 started, Heart rookie **Kaleb Caron-Martin** got the jump and the answer for the win.

Heart's **Raine Lily O'Ryan** got the first three scores of the quiz to freeze her chair without error. **Carmen Yonker** put LP Do you want to leave too? on the board. Rookie **Kaleb Caron-Martin** scored to restore Heart's lead to 70 points. Carmen scored two in a row to freeze her chair; with three questions left, she was 30 points down on Heart and could only watch and hope for an error to let her back in. **Megan Yonker** got one of those three to put LP A Dispute on the board. **Lydia Hatfield** got question 15 for a team bonus to highlight Heart's win.

#### SPN Steal & Kill & Destroy-40, ♥ Two Small Fish-0, ♥ Not Your Husband-210

This quiz saw the highest team score of the season, and it is a score that may stand as it was almost as

complete a win as is possible. Not Your Husband picked up a team bonus on question 3 as **Curtis Parker**, **Sam Hatfield** and **Owen Parker** took the first three questions. The team picked up a second bonus on question 5 as Owen completed his frozen chair. It picked up a third bonus on question 12 when Curtis completed his frozen chair. By then, rookie **Jack Smith** had St. Paul on the board with 20 points, and he added to that with another jump on 13. Sam, who was trying hard to join his teammates with a frozen chair, had picked up two errors, but he did not give up and took both questions 14 and 15 to get his frozen chair and close out the quiz.

#### Marimont Raise It Up-110, ♥ Two Small Fish-80

Marimont's errorless quizzing made the difference in this two-way quiz. Rookie **Katie Baugh** put Marimont on the board as the quiz started on question 4. Heart responded with jumps from **Noel Alvarez** and **Kayla Miller** to take the lead. A Heart error gave Katie a freebie. A jump from **Noah Trevino** put Marimont back in the lead. Another jump by Katie followed by her second freebie pushed Marimont's lead to 40 points. But two in a row for Noel froze his chair and tied it up at 80 poiints with just one question to go. Although with 60 points, Katie was not frozen yet and got the jump and answer on 15 to freeze without error and give Marimont the win.

Five DBQ teams made up almost half the field of 12 competing at the 2018 Great Lakes Open Tournament in Wayne, MI on November 17.

By and large, the teams were made up by combining quizzers from different programs. CrossPoint's two quizzers were joined by one from Heart. Lake Pointe's two representatives went on Heart and St. Paul teams. Marimont and Oakland Christian Schools quizzers combined as a "Mariland" team. This led to some great camaraderie not only during the quiz time, but also afterwards as a group of 28 went out to dinner together (see the photos accompanying the poem on the next page).

♥ Not Your Husband, the local team joined by **Noel Alvarez** and **Cordelia Fike**, finished the morning in second place. Top achievements for them were winning with 260 points in one quiz where they scored on 10 consecutive questions and had four bonuses—quizouts without error for **Owen Parker** and Cordelia and team bonuses for **Curtis Parker** and **Sam Hatfield** also getting correct questions. They scored 240 points in another quiz with four bonuses—a quizout without error and all five on the team scoring.

The rookie team from St. Paul Lutheran–Northville was joined by tournament top quizzer **Sophia Fike** and found themselves in third place after the morning preliminaries.

In the playoffs, St. Paul quizzed second into the Finals. Not Your Husband then lost Cordelia, who had to leave for a mandatory appearance in a theatrical production, and it struggled to be the third team into the finals. It had to fend off About to Die, which made a strong playoff run from 6th to challenge for that last spot in the Finals.

Another team with a strong playoff run was Team Mariland, going all the way from 11th up to 6th. That won **Annaliese Sanchez** her challenge that if the team made the top six she would get to quizmaster a practice quiz at Oakland Christian Schools.

In the Finals, as all day long, the Summit Academy team from southern Ohio showed itself to be head and shoulders above the competition. Sophia got SPN on the board with a freebie and rookie **Jack Smith** scored 50 points down the stretch to give SPN second place.




