- (1) Great Lakes. Everyone is encouraged to register for this WBQA tournament held on November 16 in Wayne, MI. Use WBQA's web site to register by Thursday, November 7. The team fee is \$40; send your check to Mona Blair per the web site instructions.
- **(2) All Timers.** This tournament is unique—everyone is welcome to quiz, regardless of age or quizzing experience, and it is free.
- (3) Chicago. For this Tournament, qualified quizzers go on DBQ teams. There are two qualification requirements: (1) quiz average and (2) attendance. One, a quizzer's average by the end of the season needs to be 20 for veterans and 10 for rookies. In a 21-quiz season, that means 420 points for veterans and 210 points for rookies. Two, a quizzer can miss no more than one day of quizzing from October through February and must be present for the March Day of Champions Tournament.

Promotion. There are many new faces this season, and for each one there is someone to thank for getting them involved in Bible quizzing. Let's keep up the good work of promoting quizzing throughout this season. See what you can do to get family, friends, acquaintances involved now. Get them to one of your practices or to a monthly quiz. Encourage, persuade or drag them (but be nice) into getting involved.

Honorable Mention. Once frozen, there is no guarantee that a quizzer will have an opportunity to jump and score again. Three frozen chairs without error in a day of quizzing equals 210 points. Then Heart took over the lead as **Kaleb Caron-Martin** got the next three scores to freeze his chair. Katie promptly tied it up with her third to freeze. On question 13, Jack got his second score to pull within 20 of the front runners. Trying hard to catch up, St. Paul came up short on question 14, and Kaleb won the toss-up. St. Paul erred again on 15, and Katie won the toss-up to end regulation and send the quiz into overtime for a tie-breaker. A Heart error let Katie back in to win the freebie and the quiz.

Quizzer of the Month **Cordelia Fike** scored on questions 2, 3 and 4 to freeze without error and post Lake Pointe to a 70-point lead. The other two teams found the going difficult and each had two errors, and Cordelia capitalized on two of them to bump her total to 110. Then **Destiny Lloyd** scored to put CrossPoint on the board. Trying to avoid third place, Heart erred and Cordelia scored again for 130 in the quiz. A Lake Pointe error on 15 cost it 10 points, and the toss-up was do-or-die for Heart trying for second place, but Destiny got the jump and the answer to lock up second and end the quiz.

In on a toss-up on 14A, Sophia bumped her total to 80. On 15, it was anyone's quiz still, but Erin Yonker got the jump and the answer to give LP Preprd the come-frombehind win.

CP Strangers and Exiles-0 SPN You Need Milk-80 ♥ God the Builder-170

St. Paul was first on the board as **Jack Smith** scored on question 1. The next four were all Heart, as **Curtis Parker** scored one followed by three in a row for **Owen Parker**. Jack came right back with 2

in a row to cut Heart's lead to 20. Then **Sam Hatfield** scored for a third-person Heart bonus, Owen scored on a toss-up, and Heart had pushed its lead back to 70. In on a question 12 toss-up, Jack cut the lead to 50, but Curtis scored again on 13 to all but lock up the win. With all three places established, the quizzers relaxed a bit and from 14 through 16 there were 5 errors and 2 attempts. On 16A, Owen brought the quiz to a close. A take-home lesson from this quiz is the value of the third-person bonus: the 2 Olympic bonus points it gave Heart made all the difference at the top of the team standings. \bullet
