game is at night though). That will cost you exactly \$2.00 for gas and parking. Tickets are free. CJ Barrymore's all you can play day is

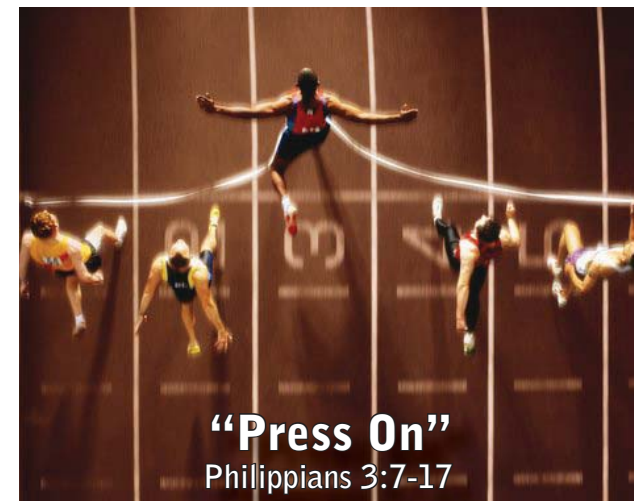
on August 12 and will cost \$14. Cedar Point will be in late July with the exact date being announced soon. Don't miss a single day!
